

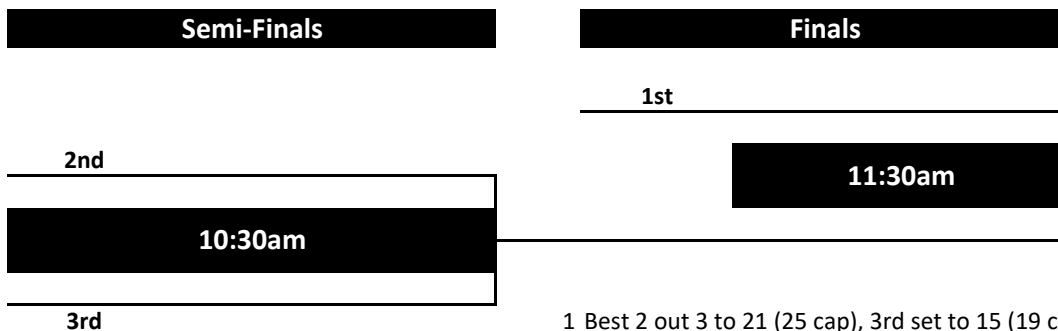

Pool Play Rules

- 1 King of The Beach (everyone plays with everyone) pool play to determine player rankings.
- 2 Player rankings are determined: 1st - matches won, 2nd - point differential, 3rd - who beat who, 4th - tie breaker.
- 3 1 game straight up to 15 points.
- 4 1 - 60 second timeout permitted per game per team.
- 6 2 - "play it over" permitted per team per game (for the questionable calls).
- 7 Difference of opinions will be settle by the ref, after all "play it overs" are utilized. If the ref is unable to settle the "call," the tournament director will make the "call." Let your game make the call for you."
- 8 Each player is required to behave professionally, cordially and respectfully. The idea is to have the highest level of competition possible while being honest and courteous to one another. It is gentlemen's game.

Brackets



- 1 1 - Game to 21 points, 25 cap
- 2 1 - 60 second time out per team
- 3 1 - 60 second technical time out at 21 points
- 4 Player ranked 1st refs
- 5 All other pool play rules apply, unless otherwise specified

- 1 Best 2 out 3 to 21 (25 cap), 3rd set to 15 (19 cap)
- 2 Player ranked 1st can choose any player, except the
- 3 winners of the semi-finals
- 4 Players chosen must have participated on the pool plays
- 5 All pool and semi-finals rules apply, unless otherwise specified

Bracket Play Rules

1. All pool play rules apply unless specified otherwise.
2. Single elimination.
3. Top ranked players will pick their partners for the playoffs from the lower ranked players.
4. No player is permitted to leave the tournament until he has been properly dismissed by the tournament director.
